- What are the outcomes we hope to achieve?



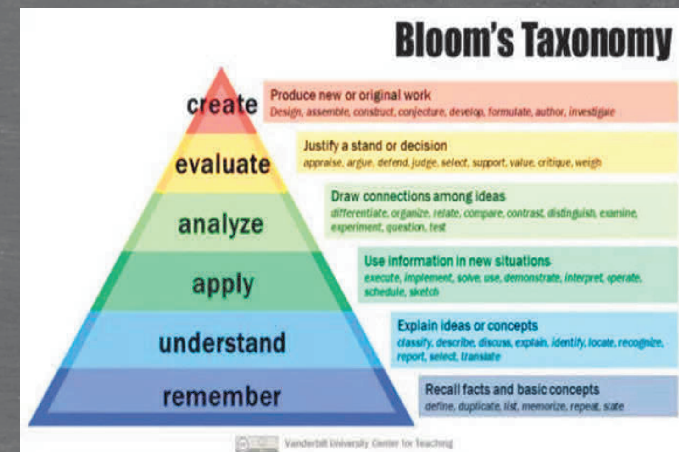

- Knowledge: What students should know and understand at course completion.
- Attitudes: Students' opinions about the subject matter of the course at completion.



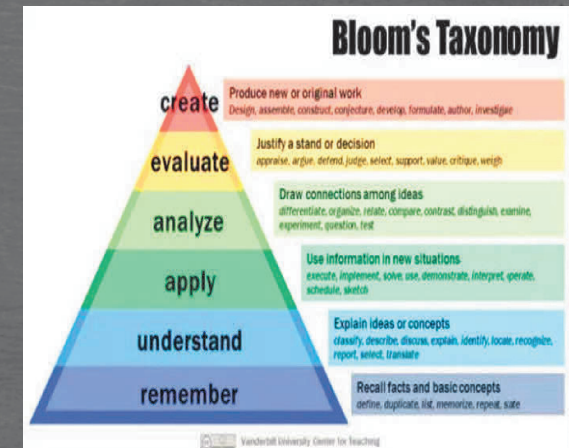
